
How to see the instructor's feedback on an assignment

When the instructor grades your paper, you will receive an email, such as:



The email will not mention your grade, nor tell you what the feedback is. That's because email is not considered a "secure" message. You will need to enter a password to see the grade and comments.

The email contains several links:

- 1) The first one (in this case, STT) is the abbreviation for the course. If you click on it, you'll be taken to a login page, and then to the main course page. If you are already logged in, you'll go straight to the course page.
- 2) The second link (Assignments) will show you all the assignments in the course so far, and if you have uploaded any papers, and if they have been graded.
- 3) The third link gives the name of the assignment. Click on that to go directly to the assignment you want to see. There you will see the name of the document that you uploaded. Scroll down to see your grade and the feedback from the instructor. We will not make marks on your papers themselves, nor return them to you with marks. All the feedback will be in the "Feedback comments" area.
